# WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS?

Professional and student journalists can submit a labour migration story in the following categories: written press, photo essay, multimedia, video or radio. The piece must have been published after 1 November 2018, and be submitted in English, French or Spanish (translations will be accepted).

# WHAT IS THE PRIZE?

Award winners will be able to choose from:

- a cash prize:** \$1,000 in the professional category, and \$300 in the student category **OR**
- a fellowship prize:** participation in a ITC-Turin training course on labour migration (or a related topic).

Winners will be announced on 18 December 2019, International Migrants Day. Winning entries will be featured on the ILO website and will be widely disseminated by the ILO and competition partners as an example of quality journalism.
